Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ from Eastern Europe:

Just as we see the beautiful signs of spring and fresh growth all around us, we also see the signs of the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ as it was prophesied in God's Word. At a time when we can be caught up with all the issues and problems surrounding us in the world, we pray that all of us will not miss the major preparation that is needed for His soon coming. My heart's desire is that we will all be found faithful doing His will on His return and not allow anything to separate us from the love of God. Whatever may come in this world, nothing should separate us from the love of God as the bible speaks very clearly and beautifully in Romans 8:35-39. The disciples asked the Lord what the signs would be in Matthew 24 regarding the coming of the Lord and the end of the age. Jesus told of a few things; watch out that no one deceives you and many will come in the Name of the Lord and deceive the very elect. Major deception is coming in this world and may the Lord help us to be able not to be deceived by false prophets. One of the most precious things that touched my heart during this time is that we saw many people who are so very dedicated, who want to do more for the Kingdom than ever before!

Practical tools were shared, how to witness to unbelievers in the most effective way with the Gospel. The best example in the bible is in John 4 regarding the Samaritan woman and Jesus at the well. We thank God for our Lord Jesus Christ who is our model in how to engage people who are not like us. Jesus was a Jew and the woman was a Samaritan and during that time, Jews were not to have anything to do with them. Jesus was used to speak into the life of this woman and the Lord **through her** reached the entire town with the Gospel. You will never know how we may witness to someone who may be used by God in a wonderful way, to touch even whole towns with the power of the Holy Spirit bringing people to salvation and genuine repentance of their sins. Please keep these workers of the Kingdom in your prayers as they prepare for the upcoming evangelistic meetings and summer camps.

We thank the Lord that it has been a great honor to receive our friend, Pastor Jeff Richards from Helena, Montana to be with us and travel through Eastern Europe. He arrived on a Tuesday evening and we started a seminar on Wednesday

morning here in our facility in Iasi. Gypsy and Romanian pastors and missionary partners from the Republic of Moldova were invited, where Pastor Jeff spoke how the



local church is the answer to the world's problems. He also taught how submission and obedience are the most important things today for God to be able to use his precious people. One of the

greatest blessings for this time together was that the gypsy, Romanian and Moldovan pastors overcame the racial issue that was between them in the past.



Please pray that the Lord would continue to strengthen the unity that He has begun among these brothers in Christ.

As we traveled from Romania we went to Cortijeni, to a house church where many people came to hear the Gospel for the first time in the Northern part of the Republic of Moldova.



As the Word was preached, many people responded to repent and receive the Lord Jesus Christ for their salvation. We prayed for the sick and the Lord had mercy in healing people, just as in Jesus' times. Even people with liver cancer and the doctor said he has no hope. Specifically, one brother called the missionary pastor that we serve along side the next morning and told how the Lord healed him and wanted to send thanks to all who prayed. He was at the end of his rope but now has victory in the Lord. Even when the doctor says there is no hope, Jesus is the answer to today's problems. Please pray for those who are new creations, that they will continue walking in His power and love.

Please also pray for this house church, which is growing quickly and becoming crowded, that the Lord would help us to work along side them to remodel a larger building. We located a house in the village, which costs about \$5,500 to



purchase the property. There is also a great need for bibles (\$8.00 each). We truly believe that it is so important that we come along side them and we pray that the Lord

would help us to participate in this church planted by young men who finished the bible school and are now serving here where people are seeking the Lord in a wonderful way.

From there we were able to speak at bible schools where Pastor Jeff (Helena, MT) preached on the person of the Holy Spirit from the old to new testament and how even today the ministry of the Holy Spirit is so important. As you can see from the group of young people below, the Lord is working in wonderful ways. Preparing these young people to do the work of the ministry and now even young women are being accepted into the school, which in the past it was only for young men.



These young women are also coming to study and learn the word of God to be used for His Kingdom. Please pray that we can continue to help

make a difference in the lives of these precious servants.

Pastor Jeff Richards had this to say about his time with us on the mission field:

"I have visited with Bro. Ghiorgi and GMI 3 times over the last 3 years and I am always astounded at the depth of relationships that GMI has with the local communities of believers. I was deeply honored to speak at a Pastors' conference for the Gypsy leaders in Iasi, Romania and encourage them in their leadership. Also, teaching a seminar and the Bible students in Corjeuti Moldova was a great blessing. The culmination of which witnessed 2 men receiving the call of God to become Pastors and 4 others to become Missionaries.

What a great blessing to witness firsthand God's unfolding heart for the people of Eastern Europe. At various evangelistic meetings and church services, we witnessed God's supernatural power for salvation, deliverance and miracle healing. Truly a testament to GMI's continued commitment to the call of God and the people of this part of the world!"

It is always a great honor to share all of these wonderful testimonies of what the Lord is doing through His humble servants. So much work would not be possible without your prayers and support, which is so very much appreciated. We pray daily that we are all found doing His will upon His return and walking victoriously in Jesus!
