By the grace of God, I had the opportunity and privilege to visit one of the churches in the southern part of the Republic of Moldova located in Slobozia. With the Lord's help we were able to share the Good News of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.



It has been a great blessing to be with them and was one of the churches that has prayed for the ministry and especially for me for complete healing. At the same time while in this area, we were able to visit their summer camp that GMI has been privileged to come along side and help (below and upper right).



There were about 100 children in attendance, with fifty percent hearing the Gospel for the first time, never having attended a summer camp. What a beautiful joy and blessing to put a smile on the face of a child as they have fun and at the same time, learn about Christ.



We thank God for all of you who have a heart to reach the children before an age where they are distracted by the things of this world and cannot hear the Good News.

As we traveled back into Romania, we were invited to minister at a church in Draguseni, the region of Galati where we have been blessed to participate in this church facility in the past. We have spoken of them many times in years past as GMI partners helped them to finalize their building project. What a joy to see different churches from different areas coming together there, many having been praying

for us and looking forward to meeting them for the first time and sharing the Word of God.



It has also been a great blessing to share in past newsletters that this is the church where the congregation has put their prejudices aside as Romanians and gypsies worship together.

We were also invited to attend a tent meeting for a different tribe of gypsies in Ivesti, Galati, Romania. It has been a great honor and privilege to be able to continue working with them and ministering alongside.



There has been a great move of God in the gypsy communities where many are still coming to the Lord even though they are looked down upon with prejudice and are thought to be deprived. But God is reaching down to them and many are coming to the Lord. Even in the pictures you can see how beautifully the women dress and how different they are from the gypsies in Draguseni. **We are so very thankful to see how they respond to the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ when it is preached with the power and demonstration of the Holy Spirit.** We are so blessed and honored to be able to see, even in spite of my infirmity and having to sit on a chair, that the response of the people to the Word of God is the same. In spite of my difficulties, I'm very thankful how people receive and answer the call of God in a wonderful way.



We are so privileged to continue to minister among the gypsies as they give their lives to the Lord in greater ways.



Most recently we were able to take a group from Iasi along with us to visit Sister Ana in Sculeni who shared with us that she had been praying and “knew that she knew” that I would be able to visit her. She is always so very thankful for all that we do for her. With the help of



our partners we were also able to visit sister Nina, to deliver wood to her for the winter. She too had a dream that I would be visiting her with “many people”. The widows and abandoned men and women are all so very thankful for the monthly food supplies that the Lord and our partners provide as well as the annual firewood project. May the Lord Jesus Christ help us to continue to provide for all of these precious souls. Won't you please consider supporting one or more of them monthly with any amount?

Words cannot express how thankful we are to our friends and partners that continue to pray and support what the Lord is doing in Eastern Europe and beyond.
