We would like to take this opportunity to thank each and every one of you who sacrificially hosted me in their homes during my extended stay in the United States. The Lord provided me the opportunity to travel to many conferences where I was able to fellowship with so many that have a heart for the lost and hurting in Eastern Europe.

It is with great joy that we share with you the wonderful answers to prayer over the last couple of months and because of our friends and partners who are guided by the Holy Spirit to give towards the needs of their brothers and sisters in Christ across the world.



Before the fall of communism, caring for elderly relatives was a tradition. Because of the lack of jobs, so many leave the country seeking work, leaving behind the orphans and elderly. They have become the most vulnerable in Eastern Europe. As many of you know, when we met Sister Adina almost a year ago, we found her living in deplorable conditions. She had lost her identity papers in a fire and is unable to even receive the little assistance (around \$45 per month) that the government would give. **Because of your compassion for the least of these, she is now living in a wonderful but humble and simple house** with a kitchen, beautiful stove and bed. She is so very thankful to all of you for what the Lord has provided her. It's such a great blessing to know that so many worked to help a sister in Christ. And an even greater blessing to see that now the national missionary brothers who have received assistance themselves are now coming from Moldova with their families only to help her in her need. National missionaries Sasha and Vitale are now reaching out themselves to other countries, bringing volunteers Igor (from Moldova) and Nicolae (from Romania) who all worked tirelessly to create a home for her and we couldn't be more thankful to them.



Cristina also worked tirelessly to make the inside comfortable and beautiful by providing the bed, linens, curtains and finishing touches. Without the government monthly assistance we will also provide her each month with basic food staples.



The community is amazed at what has taken place and she is not hesitant to be thankful first to the Lord Jesus Christ. Because of this testimony she has reached out to a gypsy woman across her road and is now holding a bible study in her home. Through the Lord's compassion and our obedience to Him, the Gospel continues to be spread and a seed of revival has been planted. Please continue to pray that the Lord would use her testimony in what He has provided her to reach the community and that He would continue to provide for her monthly basic needs as well as all the other grandmothers and elderly widows that we help each month. **Won't you please consider helping one of these precious souls at \$50 per month?**

Another wonderful praise report is that because of our dear friends and partners again heeding the call of the Lord and your overwhelming outpouring of prayer and compassion, we are in the process of purchasing an existing church building for the church in Lapusna, Moldova. After over a decade of relationship building and working in this community, the Lord is answering prayer in a mighty way.



We mentioned in the past newsletters that Brother Radu, who has a growing home church was in need of a larger building. By the grace of God, a church that will no longer be in the community offered them to purchase their existing building and they prayed earnestly for the Lord to provide them with the funds.



They are so very thankful to all of you for providing them with this opportunity to further reach their community and expand the Lord's Kingdom.



They are in the process of finalizing the payment and they have already held their first service (shown above) as most work needed to be done will not keep them from using the building. Among other things the roof will need to be replaced, so pray along with us for that need to be filled. Please also continue to pray and believe as great things are beginning to happen. **Now, there is a great excitement, as they look to acquire a property just next to their new church building where it is their heart's desire to build and establish a place for the abandoned elderly, where they can be housed and fed.** Please pray

that the Lord would enlarge their territory for His Glory!

With the harsh winter approaching quickly, we are praying that the Lord would continue to provide the funds for our annual shoe project. It is our heart's desire to not only continue to provide new quality leather boots to the orphans at the Cornesti Orphanage in Moldova, but also to those with large families and any who are in need, such as the elderly.



This is an ongoing project each year and we are so very thankful to our friends and partners who so faithfully give each year towards this project. Our dear friend continues to provide the boots at cost for \$35 per pair.



Please pray that we can even increase the amount of pairs we are able to give to those with so many needs.

As you sit at your table at Thanksgiving, would you please continue giving thanks to the Lord for the many souls who have been saved as well as for those He wants us to reach in the future. While we are still here on earth, we are not with the Lord and He still has a purpose for us to reach out to the least of these who still do not have any hope; the orphans, widows, the poor and all the people, which the Lord died for and wants to bring them hope.
