As we look to the things happening in the world and seeing the coming of the Lord very soon, it is with thankfulness for all of you and your support that this is written. We are also honored and privileged that the Lord has opened our eyes to see the signs of His coming and in keeping our eyes on Him we thank God that He will help us to continue to be faithful and fruitful in His Kingdom.

We would like to share with our dear friends and partners about the things that the Lord is doing in Eastern Europe through your prayers and support.



By the grace of God we had the opportunity to minister to young people at a youth conference in Vulcanesti, southern Republic of Moldova. Many young people came to the Lord with God's help repenting and believing in the Lord Jesus Christ and dedicating themselves to the end time harvest for the Kingdom of God. **What a blessing and honor to see young people seeking the Lord and willing to do His will.**

Continuing to travel through Romania to Vaslui, which is just south of our city of Iasi, the Lord blessed us to be part of a new church planting where evangelism is taking place. Working and ministering along side the national missionaries, many young people came and received the Lord Jesus Christ. Some of them repenting and believing in the Lord Jesus Christ who is able to forgive them of their sins and trusting in the Lord. Some of the young people who used to work in foreign countries came back to their Christian families crying to the Lord to have mercy on them. Just as the prodigal son coming back they were coming and asking genuinely for forgiveness that the blood of Jesus would cleanse them of all unrighteousness.



We are so thankful that people are still responding to the Gospel of the Kingdom of God, repenting and believing in the Lord Jesus Christ. As it says in Romans 10:9, **"If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."** We thank God for the great opportunity of serving and honoring Him.

Traveling into the Republic of Moldova, we took a family from the church in Iasi and visited sister Ana, who is one of the widows in Sculeni, Moldova.



Together with our precious young children, we prayed with her after she shared the testimony of how she has been faithful to the Lord since her youth and is now 84 years old. **We continued to pray together for the Lord to provide for wood and coal for the winter for all of the widows.** We shared in our last newsletter that now is the best time to buy the wood for winter, while demand is low. Please keep the widows in prayer that the Lord would help us provide for them again this year. She was crying and thanking the Lord for his faithfulness in the past, but even for now that he will be faithful again. We thank God that He will speak to someone's heart to help us provide for them. The cost for the complete winter for wood and coal per widow is \$500.

In June we had the privilege to host a group of Russian and Ukrainian speaking people from

Spokane, WA. Our precious brother Daniel (below far left) brought youth with him and has been used by the Lord in wonderful ways, as they were transparent in sharing their testimonies, where the people were brought to tears.



One of the young men named Peter (pictured below) was sharing his personal testimony how at the age of 13 his father left his mother with 11 children. He became discouraged and started to drink and take drugs, including heroine. His mother never married and remained faithful to the Lord praying for her children to be saved and to serve Him. One night Peter came home at 3 am and found his precious mother kneeling at her bedside, praying for her son, not knowing he had entered the house and was listening to her prayers. He told his mother then to “stop praying for me because God will never hear your prayers”. ***Crying she turned and pointed at him, “not only will you be saved, but you will serve the Lord and He will use you in a mighty and wonderful way.*** He gave me you as a gift in my life and I will not take anything less”. Three days later Peter was put in jail, his mothers’ words ringing in his hears. He cried to the Lord and asked for mercy.



After he was released he called his mother, saying, “I’m going to the rehabilitation center, at this time I don’t need your money or anything else, thank you for praying and believing God would help me, I want to know the Lord”. He went into rehab in 2015, repenting and receiving the Lord Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior. They prayed for him and he was delivered from demonic powers, being clean ever since. The Lord blessed him with a wonderful wife and they are now expecting their first child. She is in her 7th month waiting for their precious daughter.

Coming out of rehab he had nothing, but now has a home, two cars, a wonderful wife and soon to be family. The greatest thing of all is he has the opportunity to serve the Lord! Everywhere we went and they shared their testimonies of the goodness and mercy of the Lord, people were touched. Please continue to pray for them and especially those who have accepted the Lord as their Savior as we move forward in God’s grace.

As we traveled with this precious team we visited the elderly home and the Chibel family with 15 children. The father, Daniel was in Belgium and his wife Elena was in the hospital to give birth to their 15th child.



As we arrived at their home with the team we purchased food for the children who remained at home. The most wonderful thing is to be able to give a God ordained blessing! When we called the mother at the hospital, she had given birth to a healthy baby boy named David. She continued sharing on the phone through tears that their electricity was being cut from lack of money. We were able to give a blessing, which was exactly the amount she had prayed for to pay the electric bill and for it not to be cut off. We are so very thankful how our mighty God can use ordinary men to answer prayers. Please keep this precious family in prayer, as they have been able to finish a couple of rooms, ***that the Lord would help us to at least be able to give any amount to this family for clothing, food or helping with materials to finish their home. We greatly appreciate anything you can give.***

May the Lord help us to continue to be a blessing to all of these precious people with great needs and may He help all of us to be found fruitful. We appreciate your prayer and support as we see the Lord coming soon. May we all be found faithful so that when we see our Lord and Savior face to face that we will hear “well done thou, good and faithful servant”. We continue to pray for all of you daily and as you share your prayer requests with us. May the Lord bless all of you and your families abundantly our dear brothers and sisters.
