Dearest friends and partners, in spite of all the difficulties in the different parts of the world, just as you face in the US and us here in Eastern Europe, we continue working here with God's help and your continued prayer, love and support to help other people to receive the Lord Jesus Christ and be baptized. We are honored to be able to share these opportunities with you.



We recently had the opportunity to minister in the town of Darmanesti, Romania where 32 gypsy people, 12 couples, young people and husbands and wives received



the Lord Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and were baptized together. What a joy and what a blessing to see these people who have been rejected and

neglected, that now they are the ones who are rejoicing, receiving the Lord Jesus and being baptized. We did these baptisms as John the Baptist was doing in the river Jordan. You can see in the picture that we were in the river and these precious people came, confessing their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. It has been a great joy for us to be able to baptize them for the glory of the Lord and we thank Him. As we were among the gypsies, one of the most important things we can share is that you can see that they have many children. They will continue to survive generation to generation as so many others kill their children and unborn. We have shared with them the importance of continuing to raise their very beautiful children in a Godly way. Please pray along with us that the Lord would help us to continue to be involved in the lives of these precious children, for them to be educated in the Gospel, to be trained and equipped to

truly be a blessing for the future. Children are the hope for this ethnic group and a blessing for them to continue as a people. We thank God for the opportunity to be able to continue to minister among them. What a great blessing to see these little children coming with many people making a great dedication of the Lord and we pray that God would continue to bless them. As Jesus said in



Matthew 19:14, *"Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the Kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."*



We were requested to pray for a little girl who had a problem with her vision. She was scheduled to go and have surgery on her eye to improve her eyesight. The parents brought her to us, we prayed for her and the Lord touched her and healed her completely! When she went back to the doctor prior to her having surgery, he checked her eyes again and she had 20/20 vision! He told them she would not need surgery

and that she would not need to return for another year. This was a great testimony after we prayed and the pastor announced that the mother and father went to the hospital for her to be checked on. **Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever! Glory to our Lord and Savior who never changes even in a time like this.** It was a great blessing and encouragement for this community to see the power of God healing the little girl and we thank Him; may He be glorified through all of this!

What a privilege that Cristina and our two sons were able to travel along with me, including brother Banu who ministers among the gypsies. It has been a great honor to see Cristina's heart for the gypsy women and children and continue to be a great blessing to them. She was able to minister to the children and we thank God for that



opportunity. Please keep us in prayer as we travel together as a family and that the Lord would help us to make a greater impact as never before among these precious people and communities.

During this same time, Cristina was able to buy ice cream for the children after the meeting.



You can see in the picture as she was blessing them with this special treat, her heart is to make a difference, teaching, singing and loving on the children. What a blessing to reach and touch the lives of the children in these oppressed areas. ***If you reach a child, you will change the future.*** What a privilege it is to minister together along-side with all of our partners and friends as we affect the nations in a greater way!



We had the opportunity to go and minister in the town of Cont. You can see there are many children, where Cristina had the opportunity to share a message with them regarding the end times and preparing them for the second coming of the Lord Jesus Christ. We take this very serious, to look at our lives that they will be pleasing to the Lord before He returns. I pray that we can all be faithful and fruitful for the glory of God. Dear friends, there are a great many needs throughout the gypsy communities that we minister in regularly including a great need to plant churches as they open their hearts to the Lord Jesus Christ. to be able to help and be involved in this area as the Lord provides.

Also, the community of Ciurea is very large with a growing need for a church to be built, which they have



started and needs to be finished. We look forward with God's help that we may all help in some way to provide the funds needed for this gypsy church (lower left).



It was an honor to recently baptize sister Geta who was recommended to us by an old friend brother Ilie Popa who is now a missionary himself and ministering in Vienna, Austria. This sister came to us and had

terminal cancer, the doctor telling her she had no hope to live. We baptized her, anointed her with oil and prayed for her in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ and as she came out of the water, a wonderful thing happened, she received her healing! She was so joyful and now she feels stronger every day as we speak to her and encourage her. ***We have good news that Jesus is alive and well and healing and delivering people of all kinds of things.*** Alongside me was brother Radu, the young man who came from Belgium to be a missionary with us here in Romania. Please continue to pray for us that we will continue to be able to minister for the Glory of God.



We have another great opportunity before us to help a young brother named Orlando whose wife left him with three children, ages 10, 8 and 6, leaving to work in another country and never returned. He has no home and no place to stay. We have a great opportunity to purchase a home for him. We appreciate any help that would go towards the remodeling which will cost approximately \$10,000 for them to have good

conditions in which to live. It also comes with almost 2 acres of land where they could have livestock as he is very hard working. ***Please pray along with us that the Lord would provide the funds to help this young man and his children to have a new life.***

While the needs are great in Eastern Europe as in so many places around the world, we are so very honored that you have a heart for the ministry here and continue to pray and support the work when there are so many other ministries. Even as so many in the states are struggling with their own needs because of the ongoing situation with the virus. The Lord Jesus Christ is victorious! He is still on the throne and we pray that He will continue to provide for all of us, give us all peace and joy and help us to remain faithful and fruitful until He returns.
