We come with a heart of thanksgiving for all of our precious partners for the time you have been alongside with us and all of the things that the Lord has done through our co-laboring during these unusual times here in Eastern Europe and different parts of the world. We could not do it without the great blessing of your prayers, love and continued support. As we see the signs of the arrival of fall here and in the United States, we are so thankful that in spite of the pandemic and all of the obstacles which have been in our way the Lord continues to help us. Even through the difficulties from the accident which did not hold us back by the grace of God. When we reflect on the summer, it has been a blessing to see people coming to the Lord, being baptized and by the grace of God with mercy and endurance we can see that God still heals, delivers and sets the captives free! All of this is for the Glory of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, who is coming very soon.



We want to share with you a great blessing that the Lord is doing among the least of these and those looked down on here in Eastern Europe, the gypsies. As some of you know very well, our last adopted son, Timothy comes from a gypsy heritage. ***It is not enough to say we love the gypsies, but when you welcome them in your home and raise them as we go to different gypsy churches they begin to see, not that we just love them but we also care for them.***



We thank God and by His grace, together with Brother Banu (above with microphone), we are working among 17 gypsy churches in one region. Now, two months ago we started the 18<sup>th</sup> church plant in the town of Marasesti, holding evangelistic meetings in someone's yard with no building. What a great blessing that now the building has come up together with our faithful partners who believe along with us. Please pray for a great number of people to come to repentance from this community of 7000 that are searching for the truth and the only truth is the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ.

You can see from these pictures that many people were coming and were having to sit in the street so that the whole neighborhood was hearing the Good News. ***It is all because of the power of God which is to salvation for those who believe (Romans 1:16)*** and we are so



very thankful to be able to share with you.

Please pray for this church that the Lord would help us to install the heating, plastering and finishing the inside and outside. We

thank God and believe that with \$10,000 we can help to bring it to completion before the winter comes so they have a place to worship. Please be so kind as to pray and believe with us that these things are possible, as we see a great move of God and truly a revival among the



gypsies. As people harvest their crops this fall, we pray the Lord would help us to harvest more souls for the Kingdom of God!

One of the greatest blessings is to see all the children, which are the hope for every nation. The gypsy culture does not abort or adopt out, but they keep their children at any cost. **What a great blessing of God for this**



**precious church where they have so many children.** We believe and are very thankful that with the presence of God in this church it will see many children coming to the Lord, receiving salvation and their lives

changed forever. Please pray for these precious children and families that are facing difficulties especially during the pandemic.



Some of you know brother Banu, pictured left during an evangelistic meeting. Please continue to pray for him as he is a wonderful man of God, but his health has been a struggle and he is having a difficult time with resources for his medications. Please pray for him and for his family

that the Lord would help us to continue to be a blessing to him. Each month he spends around \$250 just for medication and his pension/retirement is only \$60 per month. How can you take care of yourself and your family when sick and on such a small pension? **With his wonderful character, he never complains and continues to serve the Lord.** We have known him close to 20 years, working together with him, planting churches, ministering at evangelistic meetings, water baptismal services and pastors training. We are so very thankful for our continued and wonderful relationship.



We have had a precious opportunity to disciple a young man named Michael from Uganda, working together and ministering. (pictured left sitting next to me) He finished his 6-year medical degree and

is now in his residency. One of the things the Lord spoke into our hearts is to raise young people for the ministry, so this has been a great opportunity to work together and encourage this precious young man. We do believe that the Lord has much in store for him even if he stays here with us or goes back to Uganda or perhaps other parts of the world. We are grateful for the timing as the great commission says to go and make disciples. I do believe that one of the greatest things I am thankful for, is that my legacy has been to invest my life in young men, some who are now serving in ministry. What a great blessing and honor it has been, that we can truly be a great blessing for Gods kingdom.



Brother Tiberiu is a reserve Colonel (left with microphone) and was diagnosed with two cancers, lung (from smoking) and cancer of the liver which was in the last stages. He called out to the Lord, praying Psalm 107:19-20, **“Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, and he saved them**

**from their distress. He sent out his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave.” The Lord graciously healed him and he dedicated his life to the Lord.** Now we have the privilege to disciple and work with him in church planting.
