church along with a former colonel and disciple in one of the poorest and unreached areas in the Romanian mountains called Lacul Babei. God continues to bless us as we work together in this area of Vaslui. In the pictures you will see the children and adults receiving gift distributions, feeding and helping some of the needy and poor people in the village during the Christmas season.



We are so very thankful that we are able to make a difference in their lives not only with the physical needs but to also share the Word of the Lord Jesus Christ. We pray that we will be able to continue to make a difference and we appreciate your prayers for this growing church as we have identified a piece of land to purchase and establish a church there. Please pray with us that the Lord would help us to build a facility and that people will be able to come to hear the Word of God, continue to be saved and be prepared for His soon coming!



One of the greatest blessings is that the Lord Jesus Christ said to go therefore and make disciples of all nations and that is what we continue to do here in spite of the difficulties during the pandemic. We continue to disciple people in the Word of God because we believe as it says in Matthew 24:35, **"Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away."** If people are established in the Word of God they will be able to be faithful, fruitful and be able to remain when difficulties come.



Here in Iasi we have a group of disciples (above) that gather for bible studies, worshipping together and

Pastor Joshua continues to work towards church planting, helping the orphans and widows and helping pastors to advance the Kingdom of God. We appreciate all of you that continue to help us as we are preparing to help them build a Home



of Hope because at this time they are not allowing the children to sleep in the church. They have in their hearts the

We pray that once the facility is built for about \$10,000, we will be able to establish a place where at least another 10 orphans will be taken in where they can be raised up for the glory of God. We are so thankful for the older ones Pastor Joshua has taken in and that have completed various degrees such as a master's degree in theology, engineering and nursing. Our hearts are full to see their dedication to excellence. Pastor Joshua continues with water baptisms (below) and reaching out to the people
