What an honor and privilege it is to share with you what the Lord is doing. All of these things can only be done with the precious help of our friends and partners through their giving and believing what the Lord is doing in this part of the world. We are excited to share these wonderful things for the Glory of God.

By the Grace of God, we want to thank the Lord Jesus Christ for the opportunities during this fruitful time. Even though the travel has been limited in different nations, the Lord has helped us to continue to reach into the country of India. They have been very dear to us as we minister alongside Pastor Joshua. The Lord helped us do a seminar remotely with pastors from different areas who needed to be encouraged as we were blessed to be able to refresh and minister to them. We had around 28 pastors joining us from different areas of the regions of Orisha and Andre Pradesh.



We thank God for the opportunity and that our time encouraged church planting and making disciples. Please pray for their needs which touched our hearts as they shared them. In the picture you will see the pastors that started but could not continue building their church.



As you can see the new church is made of cement blocks and they have not been able to complete the roof. We appreciate your prayer and support in that

direction as we will try to encourage and help them finalize in that area. It will cost \$7,000 to complete amid the rising costs. Please pray for all of us as we minister to them with the Lord's help.

We want to share the fruit of your continued prayer, giving and believing in the work of the ministry in Eastern Europe. What a great blessing to be able to share with you that traveling through Romania the Lord helped us as we were invited to once again minister in the town of Toflea.



For the last 11 years that we have known about this movement of the gypsies, we have been blessed to be a part, helping them with prayer, support and financial support in their church building. Continue to pray for the spirit of unity as they move forward in this great movement among the gypsy people. *Please continue to believe with us that there are great things yet to come.* 



What a great opportunity to be able to share among parents of special needs children (above) as we shared our testimony of our own daughter Nicoleta who went through 43 surgeries to restore her face and hands. They received us in a wonderful way. Not only to tell them what to do and how to do it, but we shared the suffering, the struggles and challenges of life in helping someone with special needs. Today Nicoleta is married with three children, two boys and a little girl. We are so thankful to have had these victories in life

as we shared with these parents. Please continue to pray as we learned there are many needs among them when we fellowshipped with brothers and worked alongside them to distribute wheelchairs and various things in this part of the country. We appreciate your prayers towards this part of the ministry.

We have shared with you in the past that as we travel even during the pandemic, God has been so good to us as we continue to work in the village of Lacul Babei in the mountains of Romania. We started with one believer sharing the Gospel and now we are between 25 to 30 people with children attending and crowding into two small rooms during worship meetings.



You can see in the picture that we need a new place to meet and we pray to be able to build a church on a piece of land that we have located. We trust the Lord would help us to be able to build a facility that is greatly needed for this community among an unreached group of people in the mountains where no one had been to share the Gospel. A lady moved to this town (Lacul Babei) that we had met as we were meeting in another village an hour away. They would travel this hour by wagon through the forest. We learned about the town of Lacul Babei and began the work of the ministry there where the Lord is confirming His Word with signs and wonders. In this particular



village there was a lady and her husband (Mihai and Mihaiela), who have daughter named Juliana (left). In the last 3 or 4 years they learned that she had a heart condition and did not know how they would help her with no money. In order for their daughter to have the muchneeded heart surgery, the husband traveled to Spain to work and cover the cost. But the Lord greatly blessed them as we prayed, the Lord healed this 7. almost 8-

**year-old!** As she was having a pre-surgery test, the doctor said, "she is completely healed!" and we thank

the Lord Jesus Christ that He is the same yesterday, today and forever and He is continually blessing! Please continue to pray that the Lord would help us build a church in this area and any gift towards this would be greatly appreciated.



We wanted to thank you from the bottom of our hearts and to update all of you who have so graciously given towards our family home.



What an honor and privilege to share with you that by the Grace of God we are making progress with the remodeling of our own residence and we pray to be able to move into the home in the next two to three months. While much is still to be done, Cristina has been working hard with all of the needs there. We have made progress with working on the

electrical, plumbing, and the roofing, now it's plastering, because it is a brick house. As you can see in the pictures, we are trying to move forward on all of these things and greatly appreciate any gift towards helping us finalize.

Many of you have gone through transitions in your employment and homes through all of the challenges with the pandemic and we pray that the Lord Jesus Christ would bless you all greatly, fulfilling all of your physical and spiritual needs as we move forward.
