From the bottom of our hearts we want to say thank you so much for your partnership, prayers and for all those who remain alongside us. We are so very thankful to the Lord for your friendship as we

continue to work through my recovery from the accident. The Lord has been so good to us, but I am missing the annual fall trip to the states to be with all of you at the meetings and conferences and the opportunity to fellowship with new and old friends which is always a great blessing. We appreciate all of you who continue to pray for us and would consider to help us during this time even though I am not there among you.

By the grace of God the Lord is opening doors for me to go slowly on crutches but to be in the field observing what is taking place and we want to share this with all of you. It's important for you to see the sights of how people still travel and work as we go on the mission field.



The Lord greatly blessed us to once again be in the town of Balascesti. This is the community that the Lord has helped us for so many years to work alongside them as they planted a church and it has

been mentioned in past newsletters. We are so thankful to Pastor Jeff Richards in Helena MT who came to visit Balascesti in the past and helped their church plant move forward. Now with the Lord's help, the fruit of the work remains in this community. Not only in Balascesti, but this is the time in which the Lord is using this established church plant in reaching the surrounding areas. The Lord touched their hearts as I encouraged them and shared the message that ***now is the time to be fruitful and how that the fruit which they produce would remain for eternity.***



As the bible says in John 15, if we abide in Him and Him in us we can bear much fruit. One of the greatest things that we can do is to be a fruitful vine for the Lord's glory. As I spoke with all the leaders and people of the church in Balascesti, I encouraged them to reach out to the neighboring village of Pepeni which has around 5000 people. We were looking to reach out to this community because some of the people from Pepeni were coming to the Balascesti church and now we can establish a church in that village which



would be closer for them. We thank God for one of our partners who had a heart to provide the funds to purchase a facility and now with the Lord's help we

are praying that we can remodel the building. Please pray that the Lord would help us to purchase things such as windows and doors so that we can finalize this project and they will have a wonderful place to worship. A great blessing is that this church will already have around 60 people who are saved (plus or minus) including the children. We greatly appreciate your prayers and support for this place to be

remodeled and established which will cost around \$10,000 for materials and all labor will be volunteer.

Traveling towards Sarate Veche, along the side of the road you saw not only the horse and wagons (on page 1) but also how they are working to be self-sufficient. It touched our hearts greatly how hard people work to have food for themselves for the harsh winter months.



We thank God for this great opportunity on the day of the harvest to minister to this growing community and are so thankful for the national missionary there that we have worked alongside for many years. We have



shared the story in the past of Brother Grigore's wife who had cancer, **God healed her and instead of using the money for a funeral, they used it as seed**

money for a church. With the help of our partners the Sarate Veche church has been built and established in this community and we thank God that we had the opportunity to minister to these precious people. This is the fruit of many years of relationship building and discipleship, encouraging Grigore as well as other pastors and being a blessing to them. Because of your sacrificial support the Lord is also helping us to continue to sow financially into their lives at times of



great need. As you can see (left) many people came from the surrounding area to be with us to celebrate the harvest which gave us a great opportunity to

evangelize others. Please pray that the Lord would continue to help us be a blessing to them and to reach more communities that have no other witness for the Gospel.

Recently we had the opportunity to visit one of our widowed sisters who we support with wood for the winter and had heart surgery. It was a great blessing



as the Lord Jesus Christ said in Matthew 25:36, **"I was naked and you clothed me; I was sick and you visited Me;..."**.

What an opportunity when we do this to the least of our brethren, visiting and ministering, it changes lives and transforms them in greater ways like never before. Please pray for her complete recovery and that we can continue to provide for her needs.

With winter approaching quickly, won't you please prayerfully consider helping us with the annual winter boot project where it is our hearts desire to supply winter boots/shoes for the orphans, poor and those with large families. We receive these **well-made leather boots at cost** from a dear brother in the Lord who manufacturers them (\$30 per pair). The look on their faces when they receive these is worth everything, that the orphans can play outside in the winter and those with large families do not have to take



turns wearing what few good boots they have in order to attend church. We are so very thankful to all who have helped with this vital project in the past.

Never forget that the bible says in James 1:27, **"Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble and to keep oneself unspotted from the world."** We love you all and appreciate your continued love, support and prayers for our family and the ministry.
