We are praying for 2018 to be our most fruitful year yet in the Lord's Kingdom. May He help all of us strive to walk in His will daily with our feet shod with the preparation of the Gospel (Ephesians 6:15) and His righteousness. With God all things are possible and through our co-laboring together, your prayer and support, He will enable us all to do great things in 2018!

Last year we saw the fruits of laboring together through testimonies shared in our newsletters in many parts of the ministry work we do here in Eastern Europe on the mission field and beyond.



Orphans who were placed in Christian homes (Homes of Hope above) are growing in the Lord, having their own children and beginning to walk in ministries of their own with some even attending college in Moldova and India. Such as these girls from the Home of Hope in Transnistria (above left), who are now attending college.



Orphans who have remained in the orphanages (Cornesti Orphanage above) continue to receive new winter shoes (\$30 per pair), school supplies and food supplements because of those who sow into the lives of these precious young hearts.



Widows and the poor in special circumstances are receiving wood and coal to heat their homes and to cook for the winter (\$500 per home). They also continue to receive monthly food staples. The elderly are being cared for and shown the love of Jesus Christ. Families are being restored because of the prayers of the saints and our friends and partners. Men and women's lives are being



restored with a new fresh hope through the rehabilitation centers (above left). Those who need special surgeries are receiving the care and help they need to help them live normal lives (above center and right). Large families (center left) who have many children are receiving assistance to enlarge their homes, new winter shoes, food staples and school supplies so their children can attend school.



Pastors and national missionaries are being trained at the bible schools (bottom left) and also receiving discipleship training throughout the year so they can be refreshed and

rejuvenated when they return to their towns and villages.



The gypsy communities in Romania (above) continue to see an outpouring of the Holy Spirit with revival taking place in many areas.



This is causing their home churches to bust at the seams (left) where they receive assistance to

either purchase a new building or to add on so they have room to grow. Please continue to pray for these growing congregations.



Because of your prayers and support, bibles are being provided to the national missionaries and pastors for the new converts (\$8 each). With so many new converts and those with a hunger for God's word, there is always a cry for bibles wherever we go.



Youth and children are receiving the hope of salvation or recommitting to the Lord at the annual summer camps (\$30 per child or youth).



And through all of these areas of ministry ***the most important thing that is provided is the love of Jesus Christ, the Word of God, the Hope of His salvation, the opportunity to repent, believe and be baptized*** (above) in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Without God's help and the prayers and support of partners and friends such as yourself, we could not help, encourage, teach and exhort so many throughout the year. We pray that the Lord Jesus Christ would continue to bless all of you abundantly in Him in all spiritual and physical blessings that we may be able to bless these precious ones even more and continue to reach out to the lost and hurting in an even greater way this year.
