It has been one of the greatest blessings to see how the servants of the Lord and pastors gathered together in the Republic of Moldova.



It was also a great blessing to be invited to this event, which they call a congress, where they meet once every 4 years to elect the bishop. It was a wonderful blessing to have the opportunity to represent GMI and to be thanked for collaboration with them (below, we are pictured far right).



With great joy we want to share with you that we are starting to travel more and we were also able to go and be in the gypsy church of Ploiesti, Romania where we shared the Gospel of Jesus Christ. **The Lord, with mercy, reached out to them and touched the people's spiritual and physical needs.** We thank the Lord how people are responding after this major pandemic after being set apart from each other during this challenging time.



But we thank God as we were able to go share the Gospel (above and below) where many people came to receive the Lord in spite of being destitute gypsies who are looked down upon. God is reaching out to them and we are very thankful as we wanted to share the good news with you. **They shared with us the desire to purchase a building for their growing fellowship and we pray that the Lord would provide for their needs.** Anything towards helping them purchase is greatly appreciated.



What a blessing it was as we continued to travel through the south part of Romania, in a village near the city of Calarasi. We were able to visit a gypsy brother in the Lord whose family includes 12 children and another 4 children who were taken from his oldest daughter and have remained with him to raise up.

As we ministered, we were all crowded into a small room (next page top left) where different churches came together to share the Gospel along with this brother who called for us to come and share. It was one of the most beautiful and loving groups of people with no social distancing.



We felt such a wonderful love for the Lord and a love for each other as brothers. Our hearts were moved with compassion as the Lord touched and healed us. ***We thank God for the opportunity to continue traveling and people coming to the Lord in this part of the country.***

As we continued on through this part of Romania, we visited the Peter Onofrei family who have seven children living in a 12 x 14 room.



One year ago, their oldest boy went to be with the Lord. ***It was quite interesting that the day before he went to be with the Lord, at the age of 10 he dedicated his life to His Savior.*** After which, he and his father went to a village store where he saw a set of cups that he wanted to buy his mother. He told his father that he wanted his mom to have this gift to remind her of him, but the father didn't have enough money for this gift, only to buy food. They returned home and after playing outside, the boy told his parents that his head hurt and he laid down. Not more than an hour later the ambulance came and they tried to resuscitate him but, sadly he was already gone. He was such a very special boy. The family all lived together with Peter's father-in-law. Peter had borrowed money from the bank to remodel their home and after finishing the work his father-in-law kicked them out only to become homeless with six children. His brother-in-law had one small house with one room (12 x 14) which he allowed them to live in. After leaving the country to make money to build a home for

himself, he returned and asked them to find another place to go. Since then, they have built a small 2 room house which we have helped them buy bricks to make a stove. One of the most beautiful things that happened through all of this was Peter had a very difficult time forgiving his father-in-law. Finally forgiving him, the Lord started to work in his life. One of the most difficult situations is that this precious brother is sick and it's very hard for him to work. Now is an opportunity to help and intervene with the Lord's help. With around \$7000 we would be able to finalize the two rooms which includes a kitchen and place to eat and for them to move in so they have a place to live. We so greatly appreciate anyone who would be able to help towards providing them a home.



Please continue to pray for all of the needs, but this particular need overwhelmed me with the heart's desire to help when I learned of it. Thank you so much for your continued prayers to help as many as possible.



Again, we are so very thankful to all of our dear friends and partners who have helped us purchase and to work on finishing the building of our home here. As you can see above, we are making progress.

These are just a few of the things that the Lord is doing here in Eastern Europe.
