What a great privilege we had to go to the village of Slobozia where we were invited by the gypsy community. In spite of the pandemic, people flocked to hear the Good News of the Lord Jesus Christ being preached (above). God was merciful and faithful to touch the hungry people of this area. Many people were saved, healed and delivered from the powers of darkness. We thank the Lord for this opportunity to continue sharing the Word of God in this part of the world. What a great privilege and honor to see people seeking the Lord and wanting to be part of the Kingdom of God. Please keep these new converts and their community in prayer.



We recently had the opportunity to travel to another gypsy community, the village of Grajduri, where we

have shared the Gospel in the past. The last time we were to preach under a big tent for three days, but the first night we were stopped. This time we traveled with a group of disciples from Iasi (below) and were able to go back into the community streets among the houses and hold a service and water baptism.



What a privilege to see hungry people even in these situations receiving the Lord. As we have shared in past newsletters, there is a revival taking place among the gypsy people. As the bible speaks about the wedding of the King's son in Matthew 22, to go into the highways and invite those who were not invited before, **these are the people who are not counted as worthy but are still coming to the Lord Jesus Christ.** What an honor to see these things taking place and we pray that the Lord would continue to provide these opportunities.



One of the greatest blessings is to see the fruit of our labors that remain. In the pictures above, you can see Maria, the lady in the yellow skirt to the left of Cristina that was baptized 18 years ago when we

shared the Gospel and she received the Lord. Now, 18 years later we are in Maria's community sharing the Good News of the Lord Jesus Christ where she has been such a joy to see over the years, but most important to see the fruit of our labors together in this area because of friends like you. She was so excited to see us and most precious she said, **"I am still faithful to the Lord and I am waiting for the coming of the Lord which is very soon."** What a great privilege to hear these words from her. Please continue to keep these gypsy communities in your prayers, not only for their ongoing discipleship, but also for the great needs that are among them.



One of the greatest difficulties now that we are confronted with is the churches that are closed here in Romania during the pandemic. Here we were able to go into the forest to preach the Gospel as they did during communism. We thank the Lord that He has given us another strategy and opportunity to adapt to preach His Word in the open air as we did here in Poenesti. It was a great blessing working together with one of our brothers, Tibiru, who's a formal Colonel who has been disciplined by us. What a privilege to labor together with him and preach the Gospel and hold a water baptismal service where the people made their covenant with the Lord. It has been a great honor

to witness so many receiving the Lord Jesus Christ as their Savior.



You may remember that last month we shared with you about brother Orlando, the father of three children who was abandoned by his wife and had no home. We would like to share with you, with great joy, that because of you, we were able to purchase the home with two acres that needs remodeling.

Please continue to pray that the Lord would now provide for the remodeling, as well as to provide some farm animals for them to be self-sufficient. Any amount you could give towards this would be most appreciated. We are so very thankful to all of you that reach out to these needs we share with you, so faithfully. Please pray along with us as he makes these transitions with his precious children.

We thank the Lord for the opportunities to continue to spread the Gospel in spite of all the difficulties. But we can see the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ very soon. My brothers and sisters, we would like for you to be encouraged and the most important thing is to be prepared.
