As you may know, here in Eastern Europe we have the opportunity to celebrate Easter on a different date than the US which was on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May this year. Before that date we were able to be in the village of Turbata to deliver food supplies to 55 families (above) in these communities of gypsies. What a great honor to work alongside our partners and continue to share and reach

them with the Gospel and with



compassion at this time. They were expressing thanks for vour wonderful help to provide for them basic food supplies to cook for Easter. Thank vou so much on their behalf as vou can see them

receiving the blessings to help them celebrate with their families. We are so thankful to all of you that continue to have a heart for the gypsies here in Eastern Europe.

As we continued to minister in this area, we had the opportunity to visit sister Ada who is a widow and 83 years old (below). By the grace of God, she survived major heart problems and she shared a very precious moment she experienced while she was in the hospital. She was praying and crying out to the Lord that she wanted to see Him during her difficult time.



As she was crying and had her face to the wall, Jesus appeared in the room with His hand outstretched to her. It was such a precious moment that encouraged sister Ada as she shared with us that it was not yet her time to go and that she still had a ministry here on earth. The ministry was to pray for us and the missionaries to continue to reach the lost, care for the widows and orphans and for those who are neglected. Please pray that we will be able to continue to purchase the wood for these precious widows at a good price, to be able to cut, split and dry it until winter approaches. The cost for



purchasing wood for as many as 12 widows have enough for the winter to cook and heat their homes \$500 each. We are so very thankful to those who have given generously in

the past and are deeply grateful to those who continue to

pray for these wonderful souls as we reach out to them in this special way.



What a great blessing to be able to start to travel in the Republic of Moldova again by the Grace of God where we came to Slobozia Mare (above) to work alongside Bishop Stelian and Pastor Vitale Nikitov and friends that we have helped to plant a church. We were able to minister at this mother church and also have had the opportunity to plant a satellite church in Giurgiulesti many years ago, which is a distance of about 15 miles from there.



By the Grace of God, they are now in construction (above). Please pray for them that they will be able to finish this project as we thank God for that opportunity to be faithful and fruitful. They are in need of flooring, walls and fencing which will cost around \$10,000, with the Lord's help.



Thank you, so very much dear friends and partners, for helping us to make a difference even with our personal home (bottom left). We wanted to share some progress on this construction and without your prayer, support and help we could not accomplish what we have so far. It is still ongoing and we appreciate all of you.
