With gratefulness and thanksgiving, we come before you to share and thank God for His goodness. We are enjoying the Indian summer here in Romania even with it being in the end of October. The Lord has enabled us to be able to continue to do outreach as we were blessed to go and preach at a new church planting in the Ploiesti region.



It was a great blessing to be there and to share the Good News with our precious brothers and sisters. What a great joy to see them rejoicing in the forest (above). **It was such an honor and blessing and we are so very thankful for the souls who came to know the Lord and the fellowship of the brethren.** The relationships and fellowship are the greatest things that we treasure now! You can see the joy of the young, old and middle age worshipping together and we thank God for that.



It was such a great blessing and honor in spite of everything taking place with the pandemic that young people continue to consider God's ways of marriage. We were blessed and privileged to officiate a wedding in the church of Draguseni (above) which we were able to help build along with our friends and partners. We thank God to be able to see the brothers and sisters there, once again.

Many of you remember the missionary Nicu Bodea that we supported for so many years, who labored in this area of Draguseni and who went on to his reward nine years ago. We were able to go visit Sister Maria, who is Nicu Bodea's widow (below) during our time in this region. As we encountered her, we found her with smoke in the house and her stove not working properly.



This has since worked itself out, however it is indicative of all of the widows we help who live on very little assistance. ***Please pray that the Lord would continue to help us provide them with monthly supplies of food, medical supplies, medications and wood for the harsh winter months.***

With all of our hearts we want to thank ***all of you*** who have prayed for our first adoptive daughter Nicoleta (27 years old) many years ago, which the Lord helped us to provide 43 surgeries due to the burns she received as an infant. Her heart's desire when she grew up was to be able to get married and have a family. By the grace of God and through the church in Draguseni where we ministered frequently, she met our son in law who comes from a gypsy family.



The Lord blessed us with three grandchildren through them, Philip (6 years old), Benjamin (3 years old) and we

celebrate our granddaughter, Raisa, who is now 1 year (below). It has been a great blessing to see family, spending time with them, encouraging and loving on them as they moved from Ireland and are now living in Romania.



We thank God, that we can see the fruit of our ongoing work serving the orphans. Sometimes, when you take them into your home, you do not know how they will turn out as adults, but we appreciate your continued prayer and your support in the past and in helping us to raise these precious children. Proverbs 22:6 says ***“Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it.”***

We would appreciate your prayers for the coming month with the distribution of winter shoes for the children, orphans, families with many children and the Homes of Hope. ***We are so thankful to all of you who have been faithful and helped us to make a difference in the lives of the children for so many years.*** Even this year, we would like to make a difference in the lives of those who need help such as the Cornesti Orphanage in Moldova, but we would also like to provide for those here in Romania.



The winter shoes will cost \$30 per pair which are of wonderful, sturdy quality. Please pray along with us that we can provide once again for all those children in need, so that they may play outside and attend church during the harsh winter months.



We also appreciate all the friends that have helped us and contributed so that we can attain our personal family home. We could not be more thankful for all of you that have participated as we continue to do the ministry here in Eastern Europe.

We continue to pray for all of you in the United States and for all the things that are taking place.
