As we continue to serve the Lord among the unreached people groups in the mountainous region of Romania, it is a great blessing to see them coming to the Lord and the fruits of the labors in the place that is called Poienesti. Not only preaching the Gospel but seeing the first person (brother Florin above) baptized in Lacul Babei. We thank God for this great privilege to continue to pray, to preach and now to see the fruit of this as people are deciding to follow the Lord and being baptized in water.



This is an area that is very difficult as people are full of traditional religion but not having a relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. We thank you for your continued prayer in this area, loving us and helping us to make a difference. These are the fruits of your colaboring together with us.



As we traveled to the nation of the Republic of Moldova we had the privilege to go to the church which we have been a part of for many years, planting and building in Drochia (above). While there quite a few years ago, I was sharing the Word of God and a

young child that I ministered to named Sorin was touched by the Holy Spirit, cried and repented. His story is very interesting because we had ministered to his mother as she was going to the soothsayers, the monastery and the priests to seek help to receive freedom but she found none. We would also like to share a story with you about a sister in the same area who was dying and she was crying to the Lord, making a commitment, saying "Lord if you heal me, I will repent and be baptized." We heard some testimony of a young man who was sharing how he came to the Lord as he listened to a message on an ATV.
